We have entered the time of Lent. During Lent, we journey with Jesus as he makes his way to the cross. It is a powerful season of

It can be a time of fasting when we give up something like chocolate, social media, or shopping, it can also be a time to add in generous extra offerings by giving to a charity or donating time. For me, Lent is a time of deep reflection and prayer. I journal more and wake up early to spend time in the Word. I invite you into this time. Spend this time how you need for you, but I hope that you will not just let it pass by.

Lent places liturgical churches, into a season, a rhythm that we know somewhere in our souls, and it creates a calendar not recognized by the secular world. There is a bit of quietness that settles in.

During the forty days of Lent, I pray in a different way. I ask people to give me the one prayer that really weighs heavy on their hearts. I will pray over that one prayer during the forty days. If you have such a prayer request, I hope you will allow me to hold that prayer for a while. (See me privately, or send me an email, and all, of course, are held in confidence.)

We are now on a journey with Jesus to the cross. Our faith leads us there.

May God Bless you each and every day. May you find this time meaningful and beautiful. May you find time for Jesus to enter into your hearts in new ways.

Lenten Project Homeless Bags:

During the first part of the month, please gather items on sale to fill bags for the homeless. Then bring items between Sunday, March 12-15th and place them in the labeled boxes in the Fellowship Hall. On Wednesday evening March 15th at the Soup Supper, we will eat our soup and fill the bags for the homeless prior to moving to the sanctuary for the Lenten service. As you leave, please take 2-3 bags and as you see homeless people around our county, feel free to give them a bag.

<u>Items needed</u>: (The church will provide extra-large gallon zip lock bags to hold it all)

- <u>Hygiene</u>-toothbrush, toothpaste, razor, wash cloth/hand towel, sanitizer/wipe packets, comb/brush, soap/shampoo, 3-4 band aids in zip lock;
- <u>Food</u>: Cup of soup, protein bars (easy to chew), wrapped cookies, crackers/cheese or peanut butter (individual wrapped pkg), etc., apple cider/cocoa mix/instant coffee, spoons & napkins, non-perishable fruit snacks;
- <u>Clothing</u>: men's socks (small fit women), adult stocking hats, scarves, gloves, plastic ponchos/rain gear, hand warmers;
- Dollar stores and our discount at the Grocery Outlet would be good sources.

CALLING ALL USHERS

Mutual Ministry

Did you know that there is a mutual ministry team? It is for the purpose is for problem-solving when needed. Pastor Susan is always available for conversation and private matters which are held confidential. This team is to help with conflict among the Bethany community or with difficult matters that may require different perspectives.

The Biblical way of handling conflict is – if possible, approach the person you have a conflict with and talk with them first. If that does not work bring someone with you as a witness to talk with the other person. If that does not work then you bring it to the church (the mutual ministry team) for mediation. January 2023 budget income of \$20,720.42 exceeded January 2023 budget expenses of \$13,827.37 by \$6,893.05. \$5,201.31 was income transferred from Designated Funds. The church loan balance is \$34,192.01 and Designated Funds / Savings as of December 31st are \$46,472.85. This number will show higher than expected as I went through and updated formula's to correctly tally the Misc. DF categories. 2023 YTD offerings of \$20,720.42 exceeded YTD expenses of \$13827.37 by \$6,893.05. 2022 YTD budget offerings were \$18,245.00 and YTD expenses were \$12,397.71.

Rewired our sanctuary <u>Christmas tree</u> so we don't blow its internal fuses and labeled all its connections "A,A,A" "B,B" etcetera so we hopefully don't have the same problem next time.

- "Keys Plus" <u>rekeyed</u> all the outside <u>door locks</u> and we initiated distribution of the new keys.
- We moved the eternal light pulley by the piano 8 inches to the north so as not to cast a shadow on the power-point screen.
- Pastor arranged for, Seth, a <u>sound guy</u> to come in last Wednesday at noon and he <u>solved</u> 80% of the problems with the fellowship hall system, and one of the problems with the system in the sanctuary. He also showed John and I some things we didn't know about our more complicated than necessary sound systems. John also gleaned ideas about zoom set-ups.
- Ironed the wax out of the rug below where the <u>Advent wreath</u> was. New <u>dripless candles</u> should be ordered. The existing candles would form drip fins off the side of the candle that extended past the drip catchers or splash off of them.
- We had quite a wind storm a few weeks ago that beside ripping off a few branches and also <u>blew part of the ridge cap off the portable</u> roof.

She helps figure out monies that need to be redesignated.


