Dear Bethany,

We will start out the month of October with a funfilled pet blessing, The pet blessing will kick off our confirmation year. We will end October with the grand celebration of Reformation, the birthday of the Protestant Church. We will hold that service at Trinity Lutheran Church under the "high church" umbrella.

Along with this, we will celebrate Reformation, the day that Martin Luther nailed the 95 Theses to the wall of the Wittenberg Castle. Martin was upset about something called indulgences which the church at the time was selling to free a soul from purgatory. Martin Luther watched very poor people starve and save all they had for one of these indulgences and it became an issue that ended up splitting the Catholic Church. There were other reasons already in place for the Reformation, but Martin Luther made the final split with the blow of a hammer.

It took many years for it all to come together. Many revisions and many other splits occurred creating the Methodist, Presbyterian, and Baptist churches and then many others on top of that. Each denomination has split as well giving us variations such as the ELCA, Missouri synod, Wisconsin synod, etc. Martin Luther had his great points and some pretty bad ones too. The Lutheran church is one of the only denominations that holds all of its history because Martin Luther utilized the printing press, which was the new invention of the time. We welcome new and familiar faces in our confirmation group: Say hello to Tylie, Aiden, Jonah, Gabe, Emily, Xander, and in our Seeds (honorary Sprout) Olivia. Please pray for our youth as we learn and grow in our faith journey.

Please pray for our small seeds and sprouts as we start a new year and learn and grow in our faith journey. This year the Small Seeds and Sprouts will be studying the Old Testament and I will try and highlight it more for everyone. The Old Testament is a part of our history. Much of it points to Jesus Christ as the Messiah that comes into the world. In addition, much of what Jesus did or said was to fulfill the scriptures of the Old Testament. Examples include: when Jesus rides in on the donkey, the virgin birth; and the words Jesus said on the cross, "My God My God why have you forsaken me?" come from Psalm 22.

Prayers for all of you as we move through fall and the world at large. May we be bold in our faith as Martin Luther was in his. Happy fall! Happy Reformation:

Emergency Fund for October

We are collecting money for the Kelso-Longview Family Community Resource Centers (FCRC's) and the food for Thanksgiving vacation for our Lexington and Columbia Heights Elementary Schools families. This year we will be giving the schools gift cards for the families to purchase their own food. Donations may be placed in the Emergency Fund tray any time in October for this service.

Each month, 20% of emergency funds will be given to pastor's discretionary fund (or more should pastor's fund drop below \$200), and the remaining amount will go to the featured second-mile emergency fund designated above. This is important as we have exhausted our office budget and used some of this fund to do the finger printing, etc. as we transition with our new administrative assistant.

(Grant monies will also be given to Lexington as they have a much larger population in poverty and they do a large food drive. We have supported this for a couple of years from the grants. Grant monies as needed are used to enhance the FCRC vacation boxes when needed as well and Col Hts. When their PTO does boxes.)

Land Committee ~The Lot!

Members of the Land Committee met briefly on Thursday Sept 21 to begin the land sale process. Members include Harry Blair, Randy Grambo, Joyce Croy, Phyllis Cavens, Pastor Susan, and Barb Clausen. The meeting began with the Call of Abraham and prayer for the Lord's guidance. We reviewed the lot boundary paper, thanked Harry Blair for finding the markers, discussed the process, considered two recommended realtors to interview and get estimates, and drafted a letter to the neighbors in case someone wants first option to buy at the asking price. We will keep you informed. (Sale requires a special meeting with a vote of the congregation.) We are also contacting the Synod for guidance
