## Council Meeting Minutes Continued

- **Council Retreat Update:** The council reviewed the brainstormed action plan list from the retreat, narrowed it down, and determined who could work on things. (See separate list.)
- **Advertising Easter Service-4x4 \$250-300** from Evangelism. It was decided this was too expensive and churches are not going together for a group advertisement this year. We will put notice in the Chamber News, the TDN, and other free public notices for the service schedule for Easter week.
- **Emergency/Communication-**we clarified the use of the list, and encouraged council to send cards with the Easter schedule (lavendar sheets) to those who do not attend regularly or who we are missing.  
**Staff Report** – Ginger Garner is working on learning how to do funeral & Easter bulletins which requires math, energy, and struggling with a sub-par copy machine.  
**Vacation Request-**Ginger would like to take Sept. 3,4,5 and 10, 11, 12 for vacation (a long-planned trip to Scotland); Checks will be dated & pre-printed to be signed during that time and other regular documents will be prepared in advance. We will try to cover the office with volunteers. It was moved and seconded to approve Sept. 3,4,5, 10, 11, & 12 vacation (4 remaining) for Ginger Garner. Motion carried.  
**Organization:** This summer, Ginger plans to do an office manual for all office activities. If something should come up, my hope is that someone would be able to function in my stead. She is keeping information up-to-date for the year so that there is not a rush to complete big projects last minute. If there are any projects between April and September, please let me know so I can plan to get them done.
- **Facility Use -Mothers & Toddlers-Small Seeds Room-Weekly** (no day selected)-Judy Bailey has requested the room and Pastor Susan will work out details of the room use with her. **It was moved and seconded to approve the facility use for the Small Seeds room for Mothers & Toddlers for once a week on a regular weekday for a trial period of three months (to determine if it meets the needs.)** Approval includes the sterilizing of the room, parents present, and authorization to use the Faith Room coffee pot if desired. Motion carried.

### Council Meeting Minutes– Thursday, March 14, 2024 4:00p.m.

**Call to Order and President's Report** – Barbara Clausen called to order at 4:15pm.

- Decisions made between Council Meetings: None
- Agenda Changes-Already added copy machine.

**Secretary's Report** – Beth Grambo

- Approval of February 15, 2024 Council Minutes-filed as corrected.

**Treasurer's Report** – Susan Shiu

- Expense Report-February 2024 offerings of \$6083 fell short of the budgeted expenses of \$11,720 by \$5,637. February YTD offerings of \$14,741 fell short of the 2024 YTD expenses of \$23,873 by \$9,132. February 2023 YTD offerings of \$25,168 exceeded budget expenses of \$22,122.49. (It was noted that two Sundays church was canceled and we have some people who do not pledge for more accurate planning.)
- Current Status-It was moved and seconded to freeze the general fund, (excluding salary and benefits) until the financial situation improves. Designated funds shall be spent in their line item as ESSENTIAL for the church functioning. Motion carried. If questions, please see both Pastor Susan and Barb Clausen. Barb and Susan Shiu will work to inform committee chairs of the situation. After further discussion, it was moved and seconded to authorize the treasurer encourage members who do annual 72+ giving and RMD giving to consider giving early to alleviate our cash/flow. Motion carried.
- Synod Remittance-Undesignated benevolence \$212.91 was sent.
- Emergency Fund Report- \$ 200 Cold Weather Shelter February besides Pr. Susan's discretionary fund.
- Attendance for January Avg. 51 (The increase was noted.)
