Glimmers of Hope and Thanksgiving

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. Proverbs 3: 5-6

During November, we will delve into stewardship time at Bethany (and at most churches). We ask that you turn in a pledge card for the coming year. Your pledges are how Bethany sets its budget for the coming year.

Money is a tricky subject in the church, but as a non-profit, we count on your contributions for, well, everything. From salaries to taxes to electricity to any repair to this building, it all comes from your tithes and offerings. Yet, money remains a taboo subject in any church, but as the concept of tithing has almost disappeared, we have to ask.

This year marks a new era, a smaller lot, a rebuilt portable, and a mortgage paid off. This is a glorious way to start a new year. And while we will celebrate this at the Smorgasbord with a mortgage-burning ceremony, we cannot forget that this building is 62 years old, needs maintenance, and will need further repairs in the future. We want it to stand for a long time.

You should have received a stewardship packet. In it was a pledge card. Please fill that out and return it to Bethany. You can place it in the box in the Narthex. Every pledge turned in, no matter what amount, is something to be grateful for. Also, in the packet was a leaf. Please bring that filled out with a time of thanksgiving, or a special verse, or a moment where you saw God work at Bethany or in the world. Place it on our Tree of Transformation and Care by the front door (Painter's tape is on a nearby table.) There are extra leaves to place on it, and I hope you will do so. Let's allow our thanksgiving to bloom in abundance.

In addition, we ask that you fill out an updated information sheet that includes an emergency contact. We prefer an emergency contact who is in town and could check in on you if ever needed (along with anyone who you would want to be contacted in case of emergency.)

Start writing down these moments of thanksgiving. Being grateful helps us stand in recognition of the grace that God has already bestowed on us and on this amazing Bethany community. We pray that each person who enters these doors will find a safe, Christ-driven place of gratitude, joy, and kindness. We want to be a church that blooms well into the future. Thank you for who you are and for all you do. We give God thanks and praise for each day, and we give thanks and praise to God for the loving community found here at Bethany.

Ministry of the Month: Youth Service, Fish

The Small Seeds, Sprouts, & Confirmation are led by Pastor Susan, Pat Reistroffer, and Bob Reistroffer with help from Chris Engebo. Guiding, encouraging, and educating our youth while they have fun and participate fully in the worship life of the congregation has deeply enriched our church family. This includes, Saturdays, Sunday worship & service such as Family Promise.

The Service portion of the committee is Barb Clausen, Pat Reistroffer, Bob Reistroffer, and Pastor Susan. We are eager to have members join us in the many activities we do! They include September God's Work, Our Hands; Thanksgiving and Christmas Food Card/Box gathering; Angel Tree for children/families; Lexington and Columbia Heights School partnership events (Valentine's, Mother's Day, book fairs, Literacy Nights, etc.) In addition, the committee has oversight of the grant monies. Barb Clausen finds and writes grants which then are paid on a monthly basis to the two programs that buy and prepare Weekend Go Bags for Hungry Kids. Family Community Resource Centers in Kelso and Longview also receive fall start up checks and vacation checks to help families cover the needs of families when school food is not available.

The Fish portion of our service work meets separately with Pam Van Den Driessche and her team of about twenty volunteers. They provide food boxes for families up to *ninety or more* people about every five weeks as assigned by the Cowlitz County Fish operation. FISH pays for the meat, eggs, milk, peanut butter and bread; Safeway gives products; and members' donations as well as Bethany's budget provide additional food and hygiene products as needed.
