

- **Fire/Safety Security Plan-**Fire drill was held on Sunday, 28<sup>th</sup> and some reminders were given that the left side exits out the main church door—not the stairs;

### **New Business:**.

- Power Church Contract (financial program) cost will increase the first of the year. It was moved and seconded to pay before the first of the year to get the old rate of \$455 for 2026. Motion carried.
- Partial Parking Lot Wall- An updated quote in the amount of \$15,000 as additional sections of the wall are buckling, so now it needs 110 of repair. Both companies has shown proof of insurance and licensing. We need to get clarity on the quotes. Tabled definitely to next week. (Council will then vote electronically.)


